The capital of the Northern Ireland is Belfast. The national flag of Ireland represents diagonal red cross on a white field. It's Saint Patrick's Cross. The national symbol is a green shamrock (кислица).

The capital of Wales is Cardiff. The national symbol is a yellow daffodil (нарцисс). The national flag is white and green with a red dragon on it.

The capital of Scotland is Edinburgh. People who live in Scotland speak Scots and English. There are a lot of beautiful lakes in Scotland. But the most famous of them are Loch Lomond and Loch Ness. The national emblem of Scotland is a thistle (чертополох). The national flag is a blue field with white diagonal crossed stripes. It's Saint Andrew's Cross.


